Did you ever wonder how your Hershey's bar is made? The chocolate in your bar comes from cocoa trees. 47 These cocoa beans are the raw material from which the candy bars are made. First, the pods enclosing the beans are cut off from the tree by workers. A cocoa pod has a rough leathery rind about 1.5-inch thick. It is filled with sweet, mucilaginous pulp called "baba de cacao" in South America, normally containing 30 to 50 large soft seeds (the beans) that are pinkish in color and bitter in taste. The workers then split the pods open and remove the beans. The harvested beans are then separated and stored in boxes for about a week. 48 After drying is finished, the beans are exported to countries all over the world.

Now the beans are processed into the chocolate we recognize. First, the beans are roasted so that the shells can be separated from the beans. The beans are then grounded into a paste. 49 What remains is what we know as cocoa powder. 50 And then? The soft and sweet chocolate bars are ready to go into your mouth.
