Research says that husbands do not help enough around the house. A study from an American university says it is <u>36</u> for men to do an equal share of housework. One of the biggest shopping days of the year has brought out millions of bargain hunters across the world. The day is called Black Friday. Real and online stores offer discounts of up to 70 percent on thousands of items.
