The Rohingya are often described as “the world’s most persecuted minority.” They are an ethnic group of mostly Muslims, 41 have lived for centuries in the majority Buddhist Myanmar. Currently, there are 42 1.1 million Rohingya who live in the Southeast Asian country. The Rohingya speak Rohingya or Ruaingga, a dialect that is distinct to others 43 in Rakhine State and throughout Myanmar. They are not considered one of the country’s 135 official ethnic groups and have been denied citizenship in Myanmar 44 1982, which has effectively made them stateless. Nearly all of the Rohingya in Myanmar live in the western coastal state of Rakhine and are not allowed to leave without government permission. It is one of the poorest states in the country with ghetto-like camps and a 45 of basic services and opportunities. Due to ongoing violence and persecution, hundreds of thousands of Rohingya have fled to neighboring countries either by land or boat over the course of many decades.

The United States has withdrawn from UNESCO over what it claims is the organization’s “continuing anti-Israel bias”—a move that has just been followed by Israel itself. The US State Department recently announced its intention to withdraw from the UN’s cultural, scientific and educational organization and become a permanent observer instead. The US hopes to remain a non-member observer state, in order to contribute US opinions and expertise on issues like press freedoms and protecting world heritage. The US’s decision will not effect existing UNESCO world heritage sites in the country, or prevent it from submitting sites for consideration in the future. But the US was losing a “world security partner” in UNESCO. The decision will take effect at the end of 2018.

The US helped **found** UNESCO in the wake of the Second World War, with the aim of ensuring peace through the free flow of ideas and education. The country’s withdrawal marks yet another move by the Trump administration to distance itself from global organizations. The US has withdrawn from the organization once before, during the Reagan administration. Former President Ronald Regan pulled the country from UNESCO in 1984, claiming the body was biased in favor of the Soviet Union. President George W Bush rejoined the organization in 2002, but the US pulled its funding less than 10 years later after the organization accepted Palestine as a member.
